

How to reach of Venue :

Arriving by train:

- From the railway station «**Milano Centrale**»: Metro line n.2 (green line) subway to the stop Garibaldi. Here change line and take the metro line n.5 (purple line) to the Domodossola stop. Walk as shown on the map.



Arriving by plane:

- From **Malpensa** Airport: train "Malpensa Express" to Milano Cadorna; from Cadorna F.N. station, train to Milano Domodossola (1 stop); Federchimica is at two minutes walking distance from Milano Domodossola (map).
- From Linate Airport: Bus to Railway Station "Milano Centrale"; from the Railway Station Milano Centrale": Metro Line n.2 (green line) to Railway Station "Cadorna F.N."; from Cadorna F.N. station, train to Milano Domodossola (1 stop); Federchimica is at two minutes walking distance from Milano Domodossola (please see the map).

The Committee is composed by 56 Representatives of Associated Companies, and by 13 Representatives coming from Universities and Associations, as Permanent Invitees. - SusChem, SusChem Italy and Sustainable Chemistry;
- PhD in Chemistry.
